

# Osprey Lake Retreat



## Adventures 'n' Recreation

The Osprey Lake Retreat is your 4 season adventure destination located midway between Princeton and Summerland overlooking Osprey Lake and just a stones throw from the Kettle Valley Railroad and the Trans Canada Trail.

It just doesn't get any better than this: over 1,000 sq. ft. of decks facing the lake, built in Korean BBQ, regular BBQ, hot tub, sauna, hammocks, swings, waterfall, pond and meditation area.

The distinctive large 4 bed 3 bath A frame shape blends into the local surroundings, it's often described as "Zen in the country"! The modern interior accents make the interior very comfy; there is a well stocked bookcase, cozy wood stove, home theatre system, large flat screen TV and comfy leather furniture while the panoramic views overlooking Osprey Lake offer a similar relaxing outdoor atmosphere!

Outside is a recreational paradise, the swimming area and boat launch are located right in from for easy access to a number of diverse water activities. Osprey Lake Retreat is well equipped with fishing boats, canoes, kayaks, electric motors On land we have snowshoes, X-country skis, mountain bikes and Garmin GPS unit for Geo Caching



### **Summer local activities include:**

- \*Mountain biking the world famous Kettle Valley Railway (check out our Easy Rider packages) single trek biking on hundreds of kilometres of trails and decommissioned logging roads
- \*Fly fishing on one of the Okanagan's premier trout fishing lakes
- \*Hiking on the Trans Canada Trail & Kettle valley Railway bed
- \*Kayaking
- \*Canoeing
- \*Birding and wildlife viewing
- \*Golfing (close by at the Princeton Golf Course)
- \*Horseback riding with BC Horse Vacations

- \*Snowshoeing

## Local amenities:

Osprey Lake Retreat is centrally located with the Teepee Lakes 13 km away and Eastmere and Westmere lakes about 10 km.

Link Lake is right next door to Osprey Lake and can be accessed also by the KVR. There is an electric motor restriction on this lake and the average depth is only about three meters.

Both Osprey and Link offer exceptional Rainbow trout fishing all year long.

Each lake offers a forestry campsite that has 20 to 30 camping spots. Each site is \$10/night per family and there are outhouse only facilities.

Princeton has a population of approximately 2,800 in the town and about 5,000 in the area. The town has 17 restaurants, six gas stations, a supermarket, several convenience store, pharmacy, museum, library, hospital and medical clinic. There are many recreational services such as a nine hole golf course, horserace track, rodeo grounds, swimming pool, bowling, alley, curling rink, arena and Back Roads Bike shop on Bridge

## Rates:

From the west (Vancouver) less than 4 hours

East on Hwy. 1 to Hope. Take Hwy. 3 east through Manning Park to Princeton.

About 3 hours from Vancouver.

When you get to Princeton turn left at the Petrocan gas station, sign says Princeton City Center, Merritt.

Turn on Hwy. 5A (1st right after the Petrocan) going towards Merritt.

Go across the bridge and continue 300 meters up the hill.

Turn right at Old Hedley Road, (sign says Bankier, Osprey Lake). Go 300 meters turn left on the Princeton Summerland Road, (sign will say Osprey Lake and Princeton Castle Resort).

At 36 km (40 min.) You will come to Chain Lake on the right.

Another 5 min. You will pass a cafe & general store on left

Next you will pass the fire hall on left and a Leaving Bankier sign also on left.

At about 40 km you will see Link Lake Road on right.

Osprey Lake Retreat is the next driveway on the right, look for the large Osprey Lake Retreat sign on right.

If you start to see street addresses in the 4100's or a gravel road, you have gone too far.

**The street no's of the houses are actually kilometre markers so it is very easy to keep track of your distance. Osprey Lake Retreat is located at 4021 or at the west end of Osprey Lake.**

From the north (Kelowna) less than 2 hours (option A):

Go to Summerland and follow signs towards Kettle Valley Steam Railroad train tours and Faulder.

Continue on Summerland Princeton Road for about 50 kms, signs will say Osprey Lake.

Go past Trout Creek Ranch, Thirsk Lake and Mazama Ranch (all on left)

As you approach Osprey Lake the road becomes paved (48 km) and Osprey Lake will soon be on your left side.

2 km more at the far (west) end of Osprey you will find **Osprey Lake Retreat on the left, 4021 Princeton Summerland Road.**

If you see Link Lake Road on the left or the fire hall on the right you have gone too far.

From the north (Kelowna) less than 75 min. (Option B)

From the light in Peachland, take a right on Princeton Road and follow signs towards Headwaters Fish Camp, at the 20 km mark take a left on Trout Creek Main until you reach the 40 km mark and then take a right on Princeton Summerland Road, in about 3 km on you will reach Osprey Lake on your left. Continue to the west end of lake and Osprey Lake Retreat will be on left. Osprey Lake Retreat is located at 4021 Princeton Summerland Road.

### **From Merritt and Kamloops**

Take Highway 5A south towards Princeton and take a left on Belfort Road (5 km before Princeton). Follow to Princeton Summerland Road and turn left. Follow remaining instructions from Princeton.
